1. INTRODUCTION

2. OBJECTIVE

Our Human Rights Policy ("the Policy") is the guiding principle for the Group to direct us on basic human and labour rights when operating our business. This is part of our Sustainability effort to ensure the Group can continue to thrive over the long term.

3. PRINCIPLES

3.1 Diversity and Inclusion

We believe in diversity and having an inclusive workplace. The Group will treat all employees with respect and ensure fair and equal treatment. We do not and will not tolerate discrimination of any kind in the business.

3.2 Abuse

We do not and will not tolerate any form of forced labour, illegal labour, slavery, human trafficking and sexual exploitation in our operations.

3.3 Child Labour

3.4 Safety and Health
