

# The Malaysian Construction Industry Excellence Awards 2018

The Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) presents the annual Malaysian Construction Industry Excellence Awards (MCIEA), recognising this year's outstanding individuals and organisations in the construction industry.

This is the 18th year that CIDB is presenting the prestigious awards. MCIEA is a platform to recognise individuals and organisations that have made valuable contributions to the construction industry and demonstrated excellence in enhancing its image and performance and have brought about improvements.

It creates healthy competition among industry players in the quest for excellence by showcasing best practices in project implementation. Through this award, construction industry players are strengthened domestically and internationally.

MCIEA 2018 comprises 10 award categories: (i) The Best Contractor; (ii) The Best Project; (iii) Quality Assessment System for Building Construction Works (QLASSIC); (iv) Safety and Health; (v) Green Building Award; (vi) IBS Award; (vii) Innovation Award; (viii) International Achievement; (ix) Builder of the Year; and (x) Individual awards.

The closing date for nominations and submissions was March 30. The Best Contractor category is open to local Grade G1 to G6 contractors that are registered with CIDB. The Best Project Awards are open to clients, contractors registered with CIDB and consultants. Projects submitted must have been completed between July 1, 2015 and Dec 31, 2017, with the Certificate of Practical Completion (CPC) or Certificate of Compliance and Completion (CCC).

This year's judges were KLIA Premier Holdings Sdn Bhd president and CEO Tan Sri Dato' Dr Ir Jamilus Hussein, Public Works Department director-general Dato' Sri Dr Ir Roslan Md Taha, Department of Occupational Safety and Health director-general Ir Hj Omar Mat Piah, Association of Consulting Engineers Malaysia immediate past president Ir Prem Kumar, KPK Quantity Surveyors (Semenanjung) Sdn Bhd managing director Dato' Sri Kandan Kanagaintiram, Konsortium Malaysia managing director Tuan Hj Ir Alhadi Ibrahim, IJM Corp Bhd CEO and managing director Dato' Soam Heng Choon, SNO Architects Sdn Bhd director Ar Saifuddin Ahmad, Sime Darby Property Bhd chief operating officer Dato' Wan Hashimi Albakri Wan Ahmad Amin Jaffri, UEM Group Bhd group chief business development officer Datuk Nik Airina Nik Jaffar, and KLCC Projeks Sdn Bhd executive director Dato' Hashimah Hashim.

Each recipient receives a trophy and certificate of excellence with permission to use the MCIEA Award logo in their publications for a year, effective from the date of receiving the award. Free publicity will be given to their products and services in CIDB publications for a year, effective from the date of receiving the award, as well as on the CIDB website and other media platforms.

Contractors will be awarded 40 Contractor Continuous Development (CCD) points and selected recipients will be invited

to share their experience and knowledge in MCIEA seminars.

The MCIEA 2018 awards presentation ceremony was held on Sept 28.

### THE BEST CONTRACTOR AWARDS

The Best Contractor category is open to local contractors from Grade G1 to G6 that are registered with CIDB. They reward local contractors who have demonstrated overall excellence in their company performance and project implementation. The categories are Best Contractor Grade G1, to Best Contractor Grade G6.

The evaluation is based on the company's performance, technical capabilities and adoption of best practices in project implementation.

### THE BEST PROJECT AWARDS

This category is open to clients, contractors registered with CIDB and consultants and acknowledges projects that have demonstrated excellence in implementation with appreciation given to clients, contractors and leading consultants. This category is divided into building and infrastructure, comprising small — (contract value less than RM20 million), medium (RM20 million to RM100 million) and major (more than RM100 million) — projects. Evaluation is based on concept, design and planning, construction and recognition.

### QLASSIC AWARD

This award commends clients and contractors whose projects scored the highest QLASSIC marks for residential and non-residential projects. The choice of recipients is based on the records available to CIDB for the QLASSIC programme.

### SAFETY AND HEALTH AWARD

The contractor whose project scores the highest marks in the Safety and Health Assessment System in Construction (SHASSIC) for best practices in safety and health takes this award home. Recipients are chosen based on records available to CIDB for the SHASSIC programme.

### GREEN BUILDING AWARD

The Green Building Award is open to clients, contractors registered with CIDB and leading consultants. It honours building projects that have adopted green and sustainable concepts, practices or techniques in their implementation. Evaluation is based on practices used in the whole construction cycle, including green design, construction operation and maintenance, sustainability, impact on the environment, application of green innovation construction and accreditation or certification received (for example, EMS: ISO 14001).

### IBS AWARD

This award recognises projects that have effectively adopted and utilised the Industrialised Building System (IBS), acknowledging clients, contractors and leading consultants. The evaluation is based on the quality of the overall design, quality of the workmanship, IBS score, minimisation of wastage throughout the construction process, ease of installation and



jointing method and adoption of the open system concept.

#### INNOVATION AWARD

The Malaysian individual or team who have produced ideas, concepts, products, processes, techniques or technologies that can improve efficiency and productivity of project implementation and/or the construction industry are acknowledged with this award. Evaluation is based on innovation, economic benefit and sustainability.

#### INTERNATIONAL ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

This award recognises Malaysian contractors who have achieved outstanding and credible recognition in construction ventures overseas. Evaluation is based on the level of involvement in the international market including number of projects, values and country; the adoption of an overall quality management system; the degree of participation in international promotion programmes organised locally or internationally; the ability to overcome international construction challenges, market difficulties, degree of complexity, cultural barriers, different style of management and any operational practices that are related to the industry; the ability to project an excellent image of Malaysia (track record); timeliness in completing projects; host country perception; types of involvement and value of projects; and the overall contribution to the Malaysian economy (utilisation of Malaysian resources such as subcontractors, products, suppliers and consultants).

#### BUILDER OF THE YEAR AWARD

This award rewards the local Grade G7 contractor that has demonstrated overall excellence in the company's performance and project implementation. Evaluation is based on company performance, technical capabilities and adoption of best practices in project implementation.

#### INDIVIDUAL AWARDS

There are three awards in this category.

The Construction Leading Lady Award acknowledges women who best represent the qualities and attributes of a prominent construction industry player and who have contributed significantly to the development of the Malaysian construction industry.

The CEO of the Year Award recognises an individual who has successfully managed, directed and moulded the company they lead and contributed significantly to the development of the Malaysian construction industry.

The Prominent Player Award goes to the individual who best represents the qualities and attributes of a prominent construction industry player and has contributed significantly to the development of the Malaysian construction industry.


