Pestech bags RM52m power grid development project

PESTECH International Bhd's wholly owned subsidiary company, Pestech Sdn Bhd, has secured a contract worth RM52.23 million from PNG Power Ltd (PPL) for the Port Moresby Power Grid development project in Papua New Guinea (PNG).

In a filing to the local bourse last Friday, the integrated electric power technology service providers noted the project is for the procurement of plant, design, supply, installation,

testing and commissioning of a KilaKila 66/11kV substation and 66kV double circuit transmission line.

PPL is a fully integrated power authority responsible for generation, transmission, distribution and retailing of electricity throughout PNG and servicing individual electricity consumers.

The project is expected to start in November 2016 and completed within 730 days from the commencement date.
